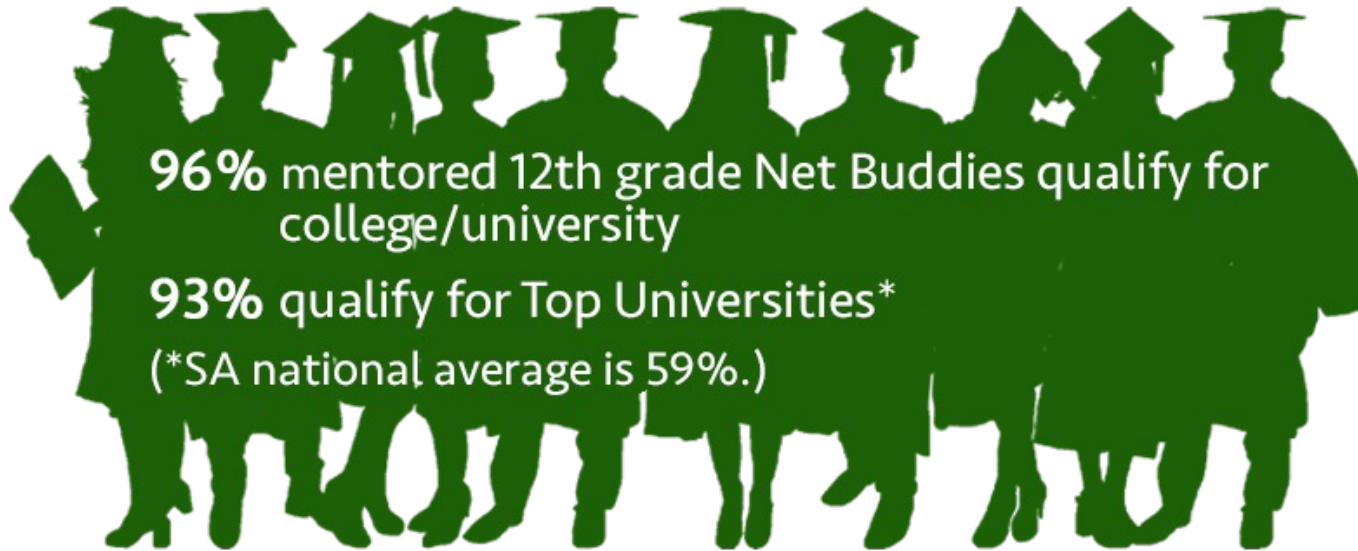

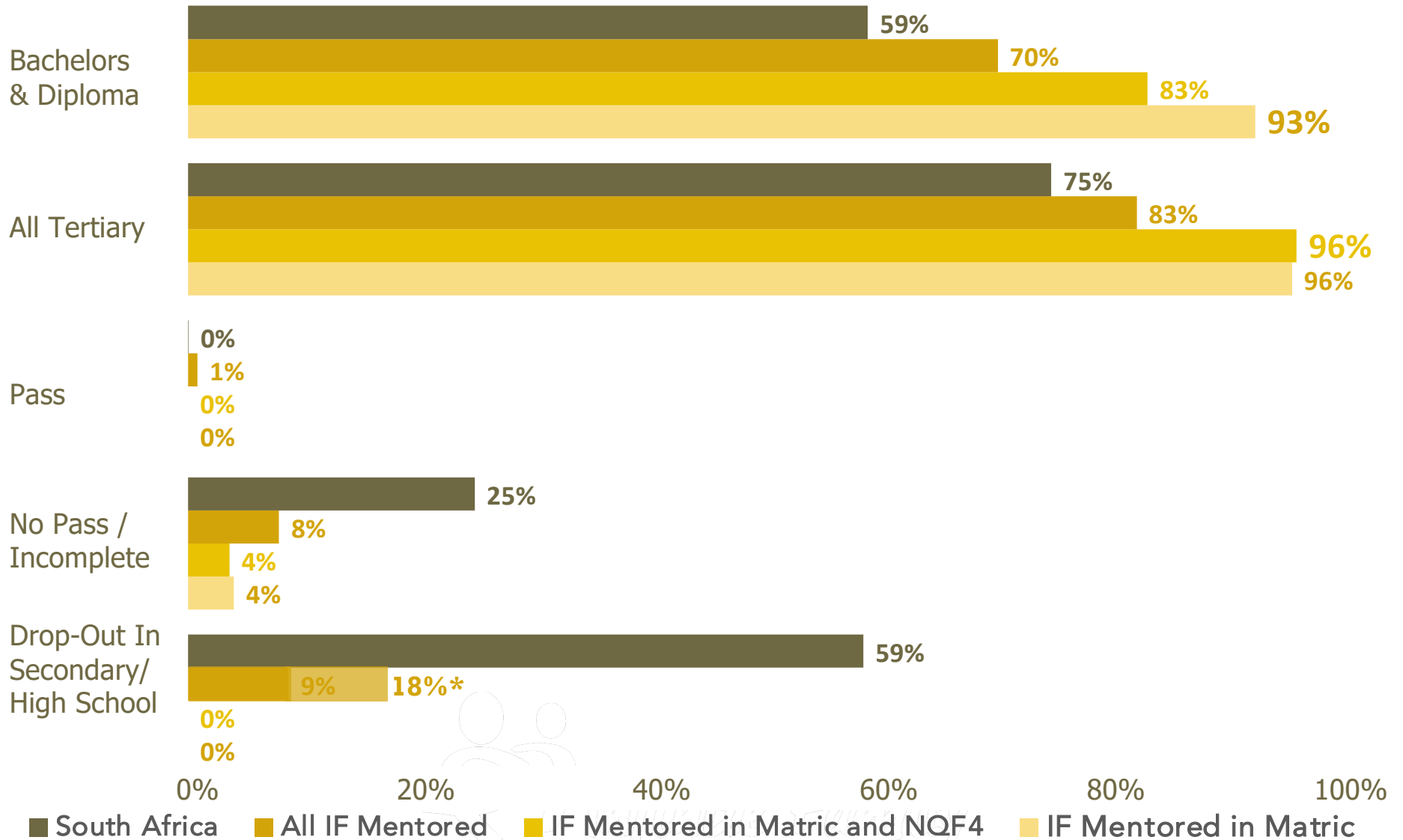

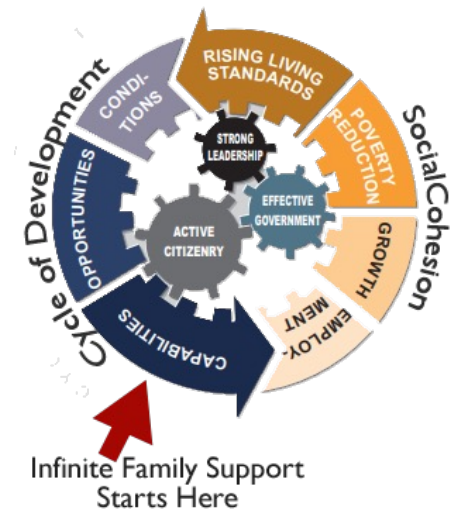


# Online mentoring supports global and national uplift goals.
